Age Levels: 21 years and older (students who look 26 will be asked to show proof of age)

Class Description: It's a little bit art, a little bit wine (or beer!), and a whole lot of inspiration! Each session will introduce artists to a different art medium, working in a relaxed atmosphere of fun and creativity. All supplies, two glasses of wine, and light appetizers included. **All supplies are provided**

Class Objectives/Goals:

Students will experiment with creating art in a relaxed atmosphere, while enjoying wine and appetizers. Students will be introduced to the tools and materials for creating art in a variety of media, including acrylic paint, watercolor media, ink and gold leaf illumination, and fused glass enameling.

Session 1: Introduction to Acrylic Painting with David Kinker

Students will be introduced to the unique properties and versatility of acrylic paints. Following an overview of techniques and tools, students will put their skills into action to create a landscape, or other composition.

Session 2: Watercolor Zen with Sondra Holtzman

In Watercolor Zen, we will explore the mysterious and magnificent properties of watercolor as a spontaneous and surprising medium. The emphasis will be on simplicity of shape and line, movement and feeling as opposed to realistic rendering of a body of work. Prepare to release expectation and explore your own inner landscape. Dress for an art class, and/or bring a smock or apron.

Session 3: Celtic Knot Illuminated Bookmark with Christine Elder

Create a beautiful Celtic inspired bookmark suitable for a holiday gift in this 3 hour workshop. Participants will be guided in the design and creation of a bookmark using traditional techniques and the highest quality materials, using gold gilding and making fresh egg tempera paint. Choose from a variety of traditional Celtic calligraphy hands and designs to complete your project. ***\$10 Materials Fee due to instructor at start of class.***

Session 4: Enameled Cabochon Jewelry with Julia Christoferson

Sparkly, colorful and mysterious, glass with a dichroic coating is especially beautiful in jewelry. In this class, we'll take it one step further by applying a coating of glass enamel to the dichroic finish and then etching parts of the enamel away to uncover the sparkly dichroic coating underneath. In this class each student will make four 1" square cabochons (or the equivalent) to be worn as pendants. ***\$32 Materials Fee due to instructor at start of class.***
